A copy of the citation is automatically submitted electronically to the agency for supervisors to review, and can also be submitted to the agency RMS or court CMS. No re-entry of data is required. All agency participants have full review rights to existing citations – provided user rights are met – with instant access to criminal history information, where necessary. Agency participants can add case notes, photographs, additional reports and other information, without affecting the original document.
